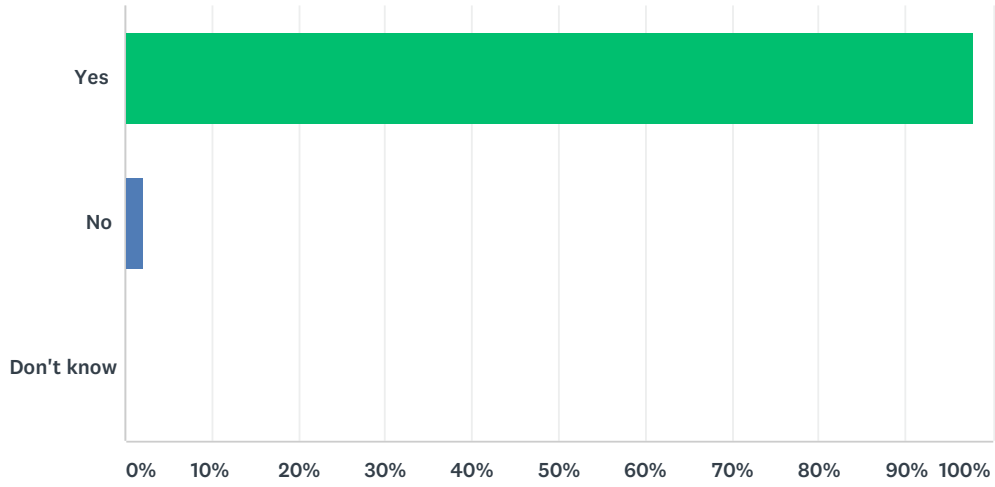


Q1 Do you think that traffic speed is a problem on Ravenswood Drive?

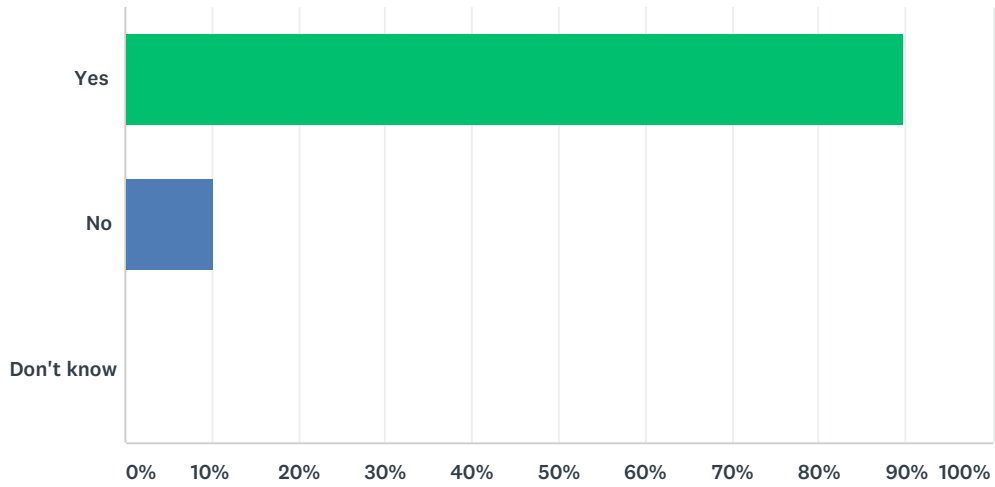

Q2 Do you think that the volume of traffic is a problem on Ravenswood Drive?

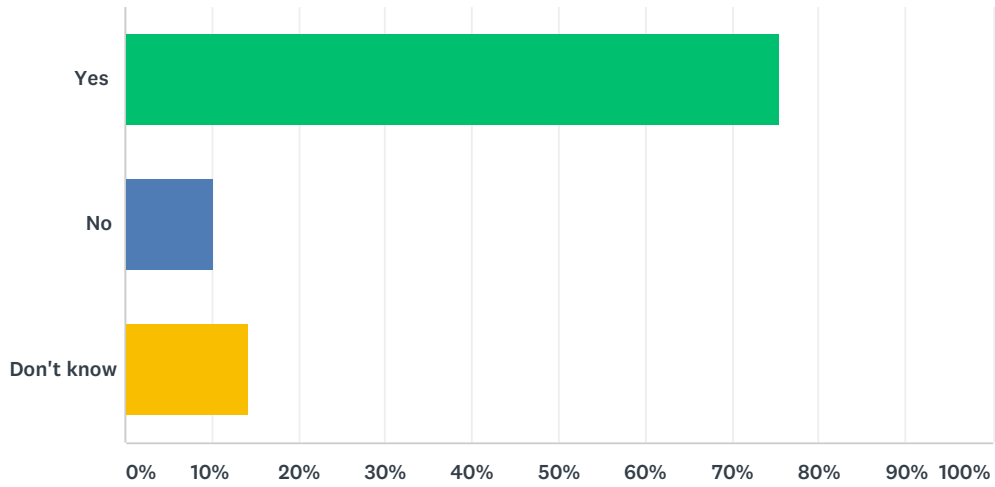

Q3 Do you think that school drop-off traffic is a problem on Ravenswood Drive?

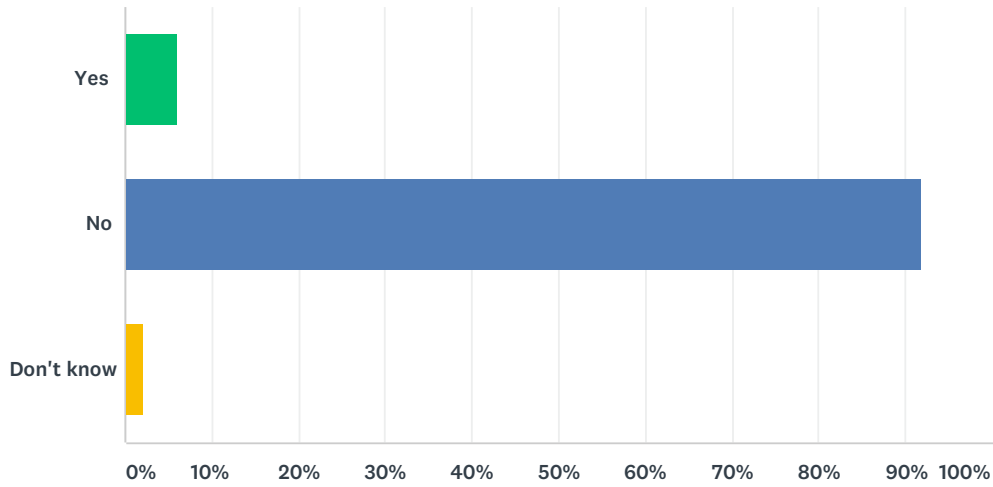

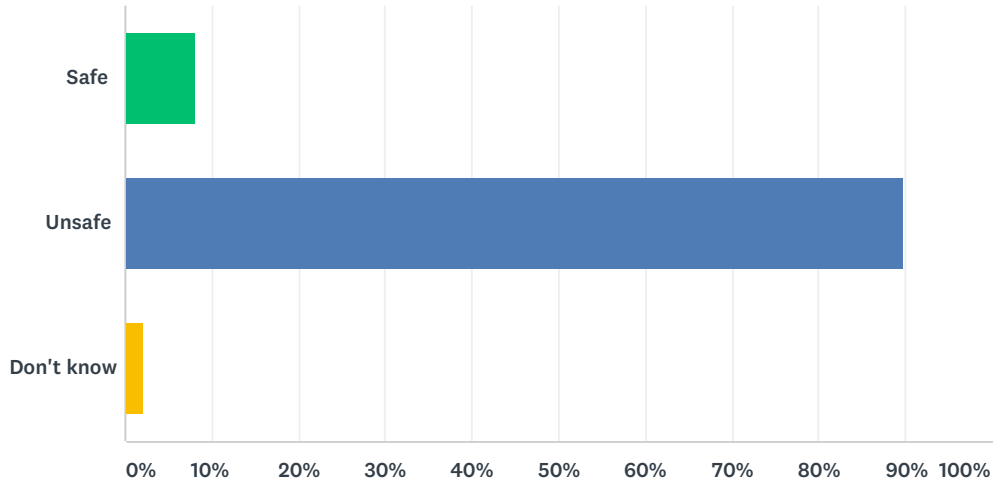

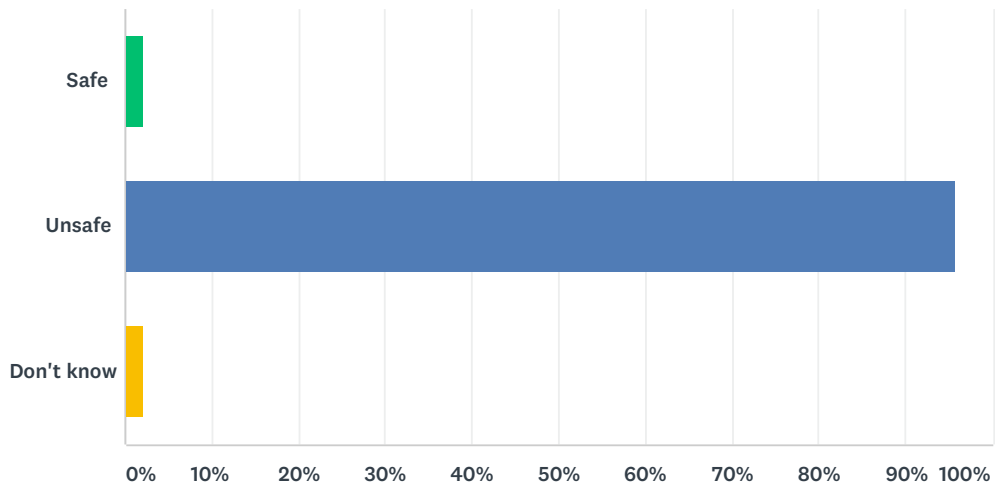

Q6 Do you think it is safe or unsafe for a primary school age child to cycle unsupervised on Ravenswood Drive?

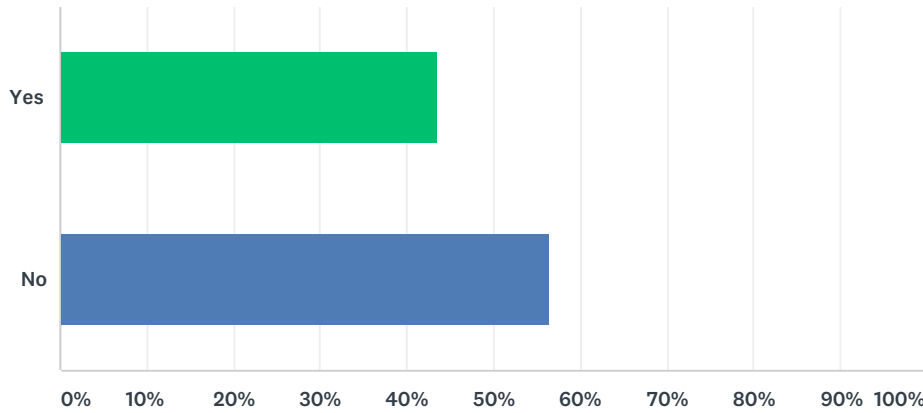

Q7 Do you currently have primary school age or younger dependents living with you? (you can skip this question if you would rather not say)

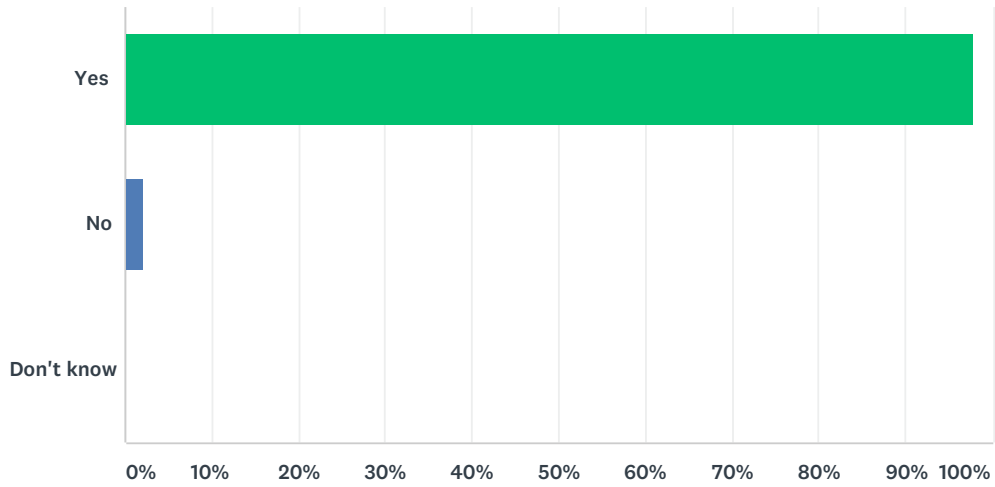

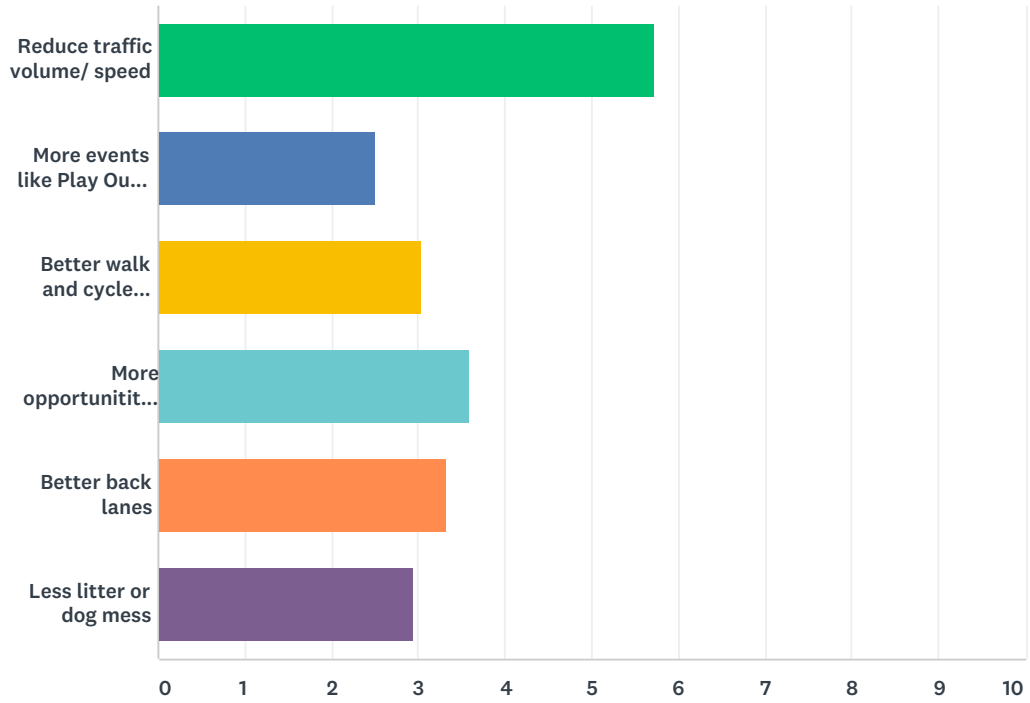

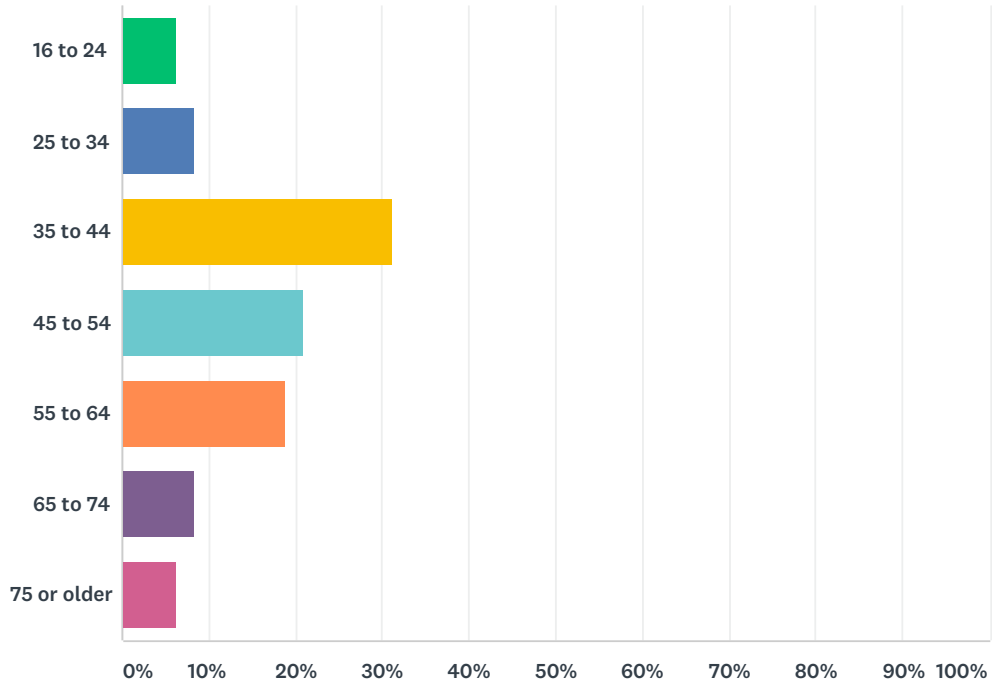
